Glen Carlou is situated in the Simonsberg Mountain foothills in the Paarl region of South Africa's Western Cape, and encompasses a variety of slopes and aspects. Of the current 31 blocks planted, each is nurtured according to its own unique potential, respecting the natural cycles of the vines. A vineyard replanting programme is currently underway so as to be adding five hectares per year. Hardier, tougher drought resistant rootstocks and new varietal clonal selections are being planted.

Our 145 hectare property transferred back to local ownership when in 2016 Glen Carlou was purchased by a South African family consortium.

The rich tapestries of passionate people interwoven with insightful custodians have shaped and continue to develop Glen Carlou Vineyards.

Vinification	Grapes were picked at 3 different maturity levels, and fermented separately with selected yeast strains enhancing a specific profile on each component. The complexity was developed by three months of lees contact on all components, before final blending and bottling.
Optimum Drinkability	Drink now; best within three years of vintage.
